Read: Joshua 24:15, Proverbs 24:3-4, Isaiah 32:18, Proverbs 3:33, Psalm 127:1, Deuteronomy 6:5-9

Prayer Focus

Pray

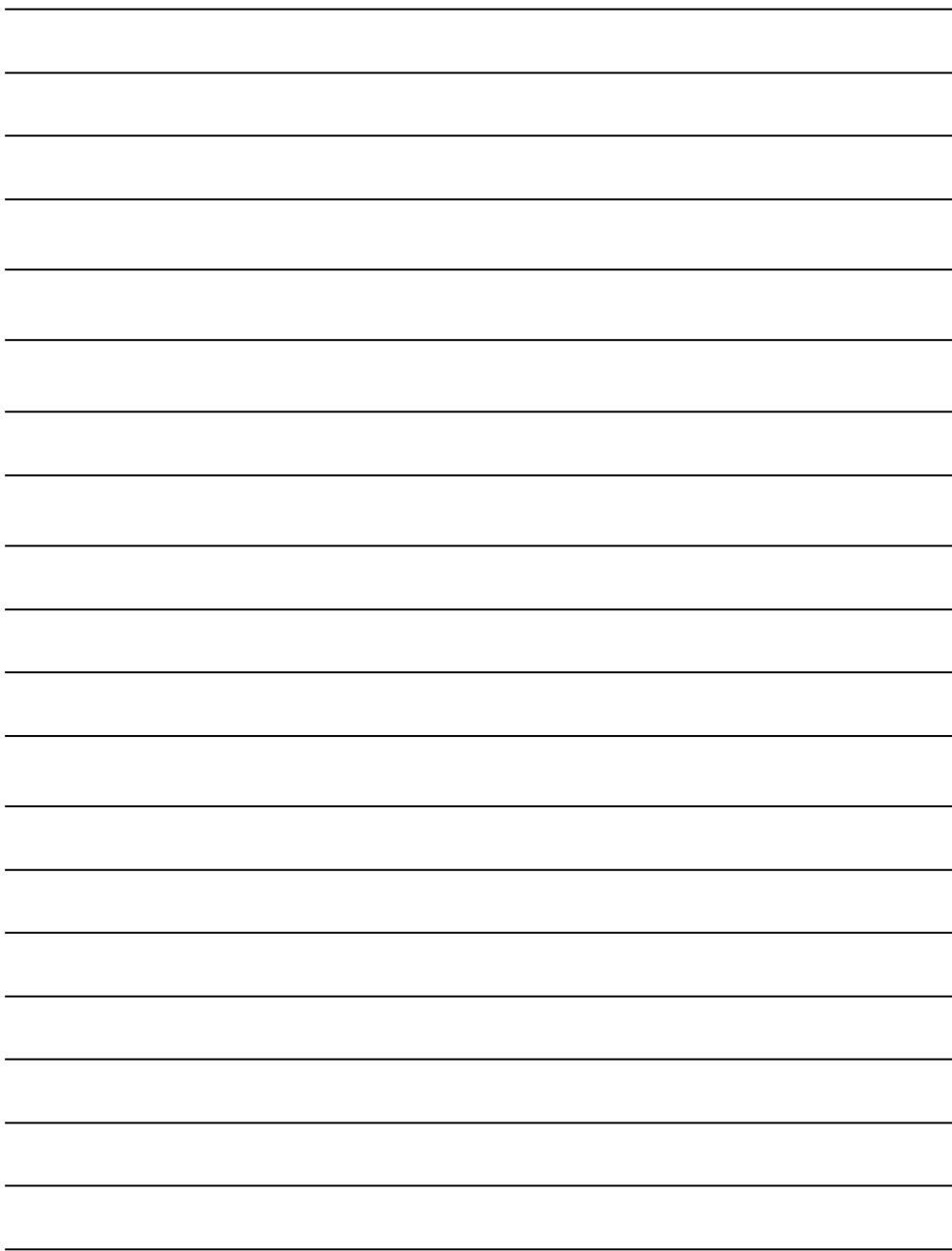

Pray

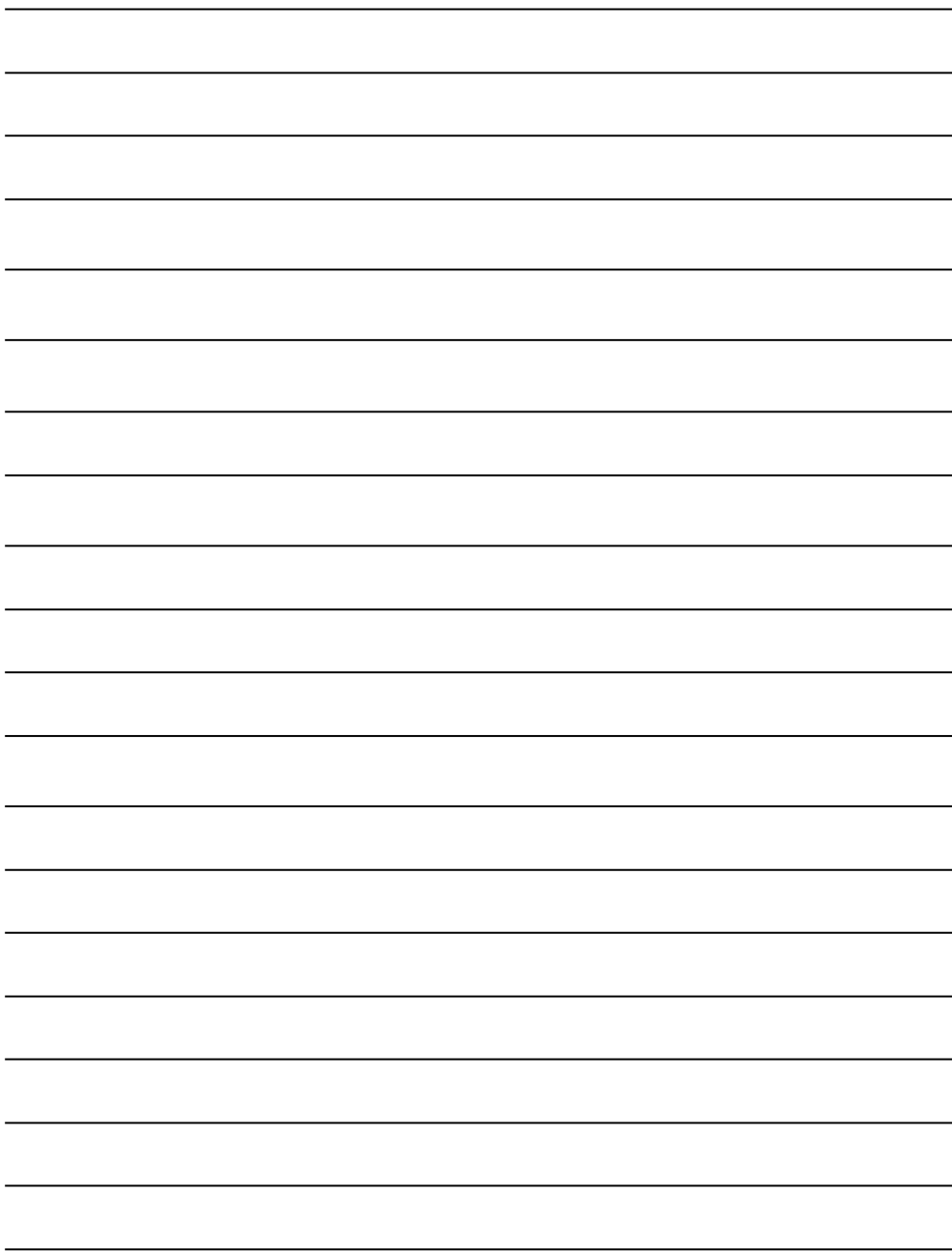

Pray

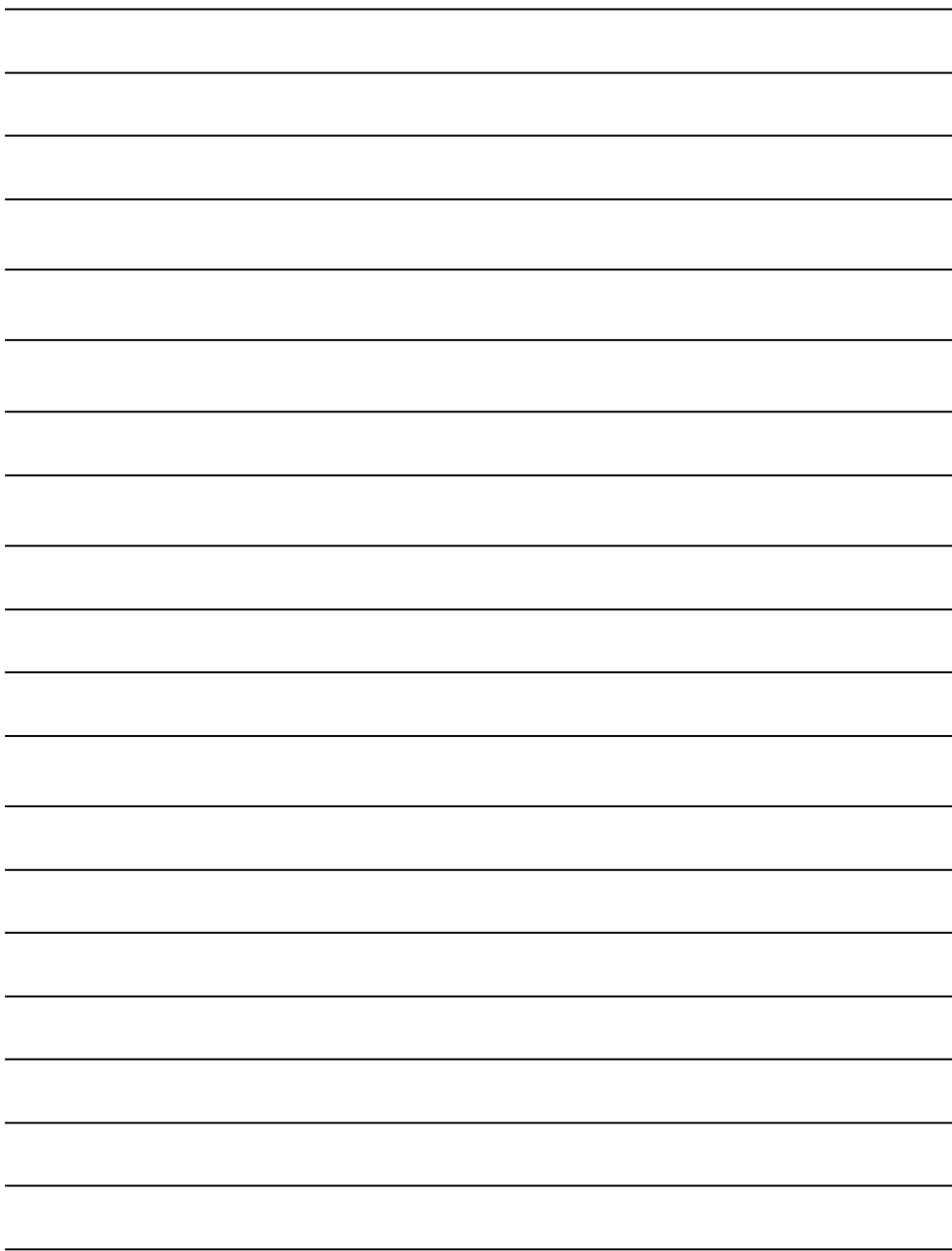

Pray

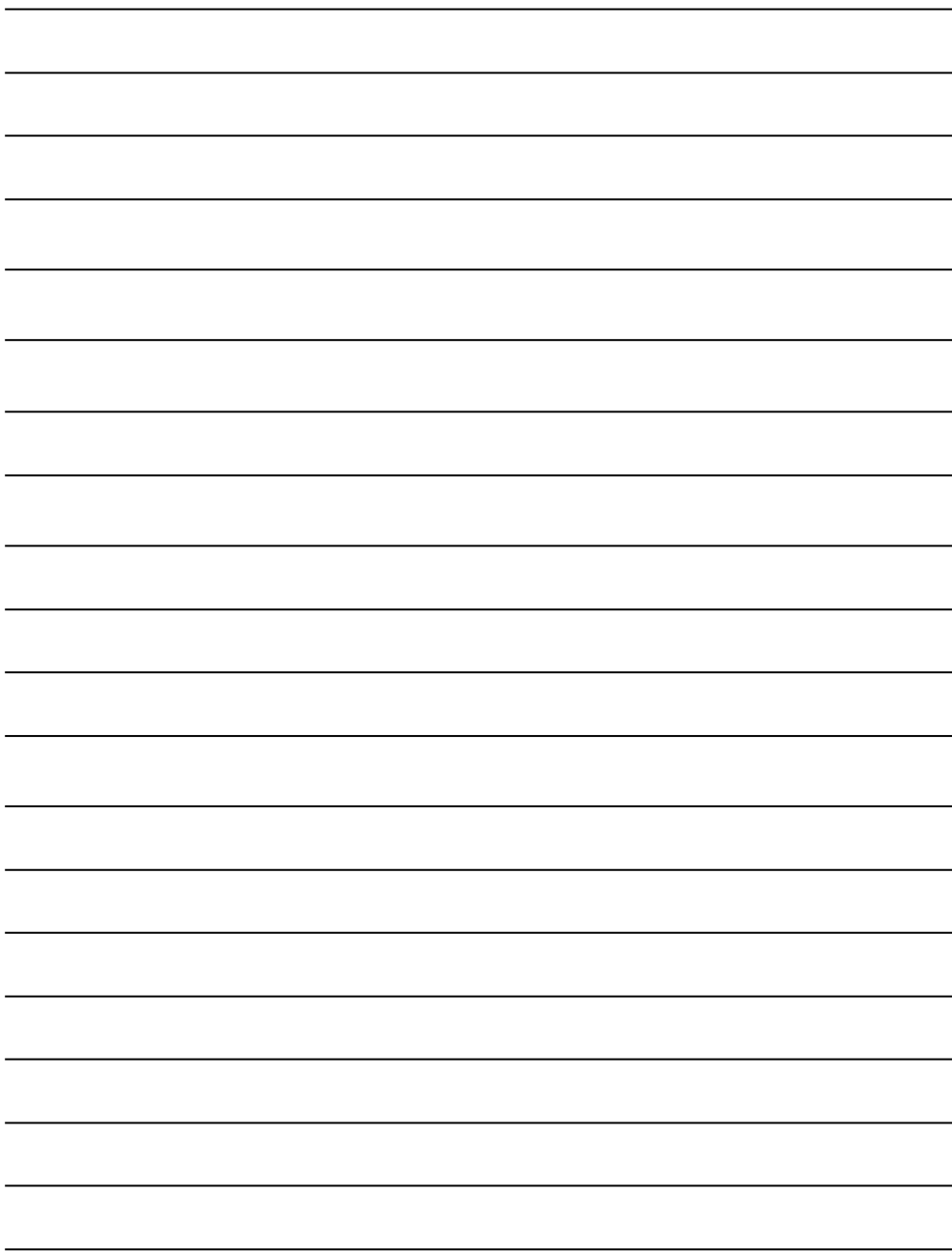

Pray

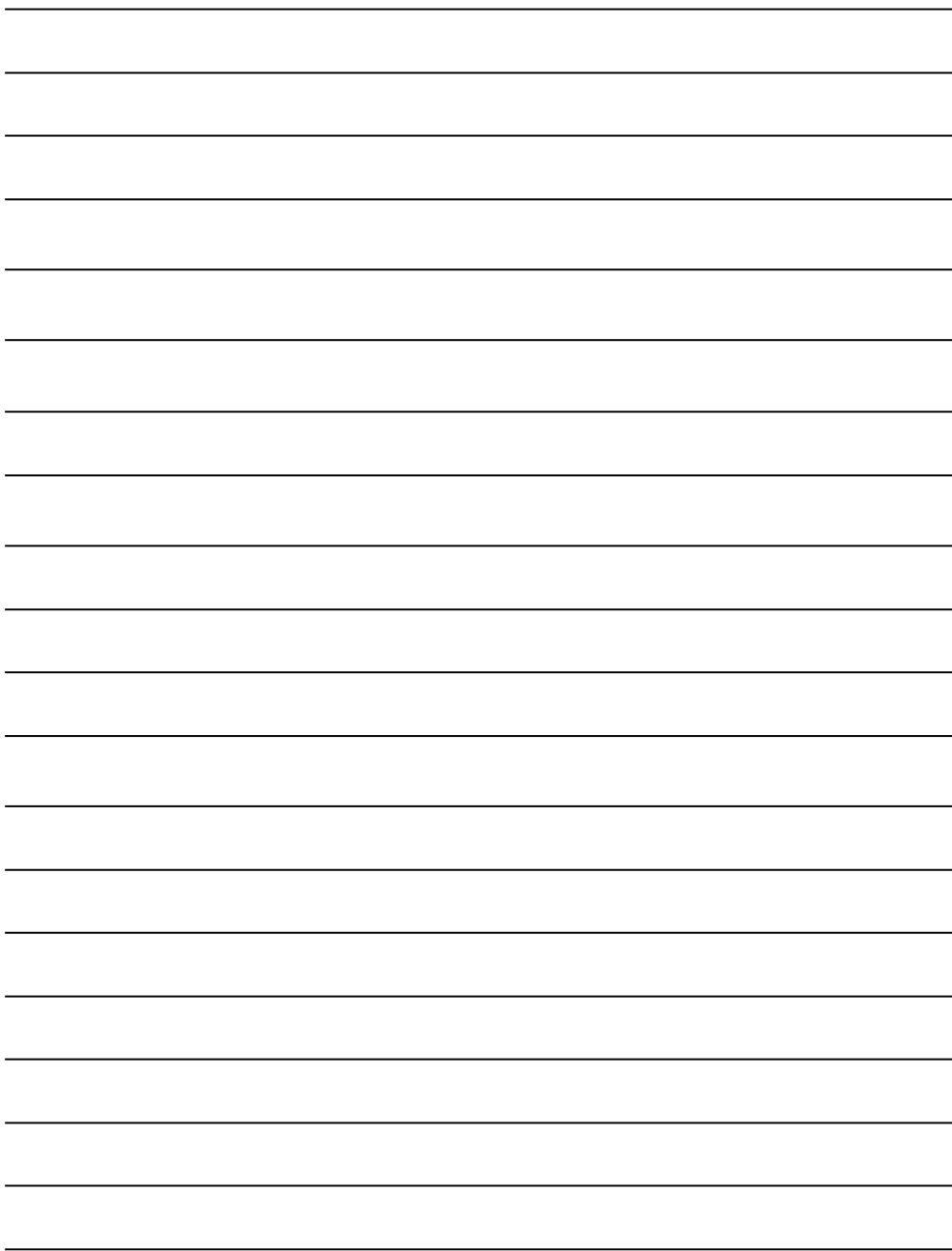

Pray

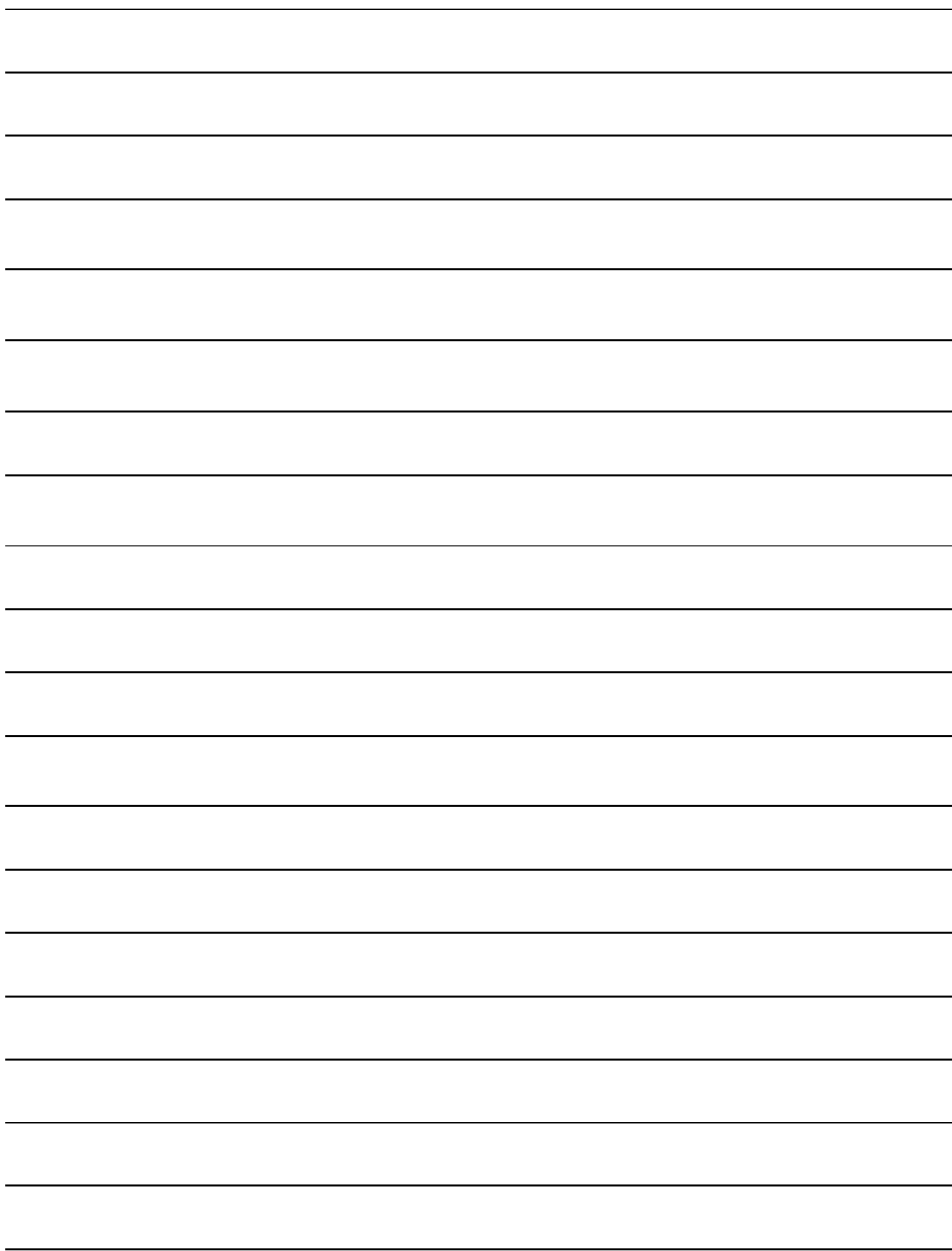

Pray

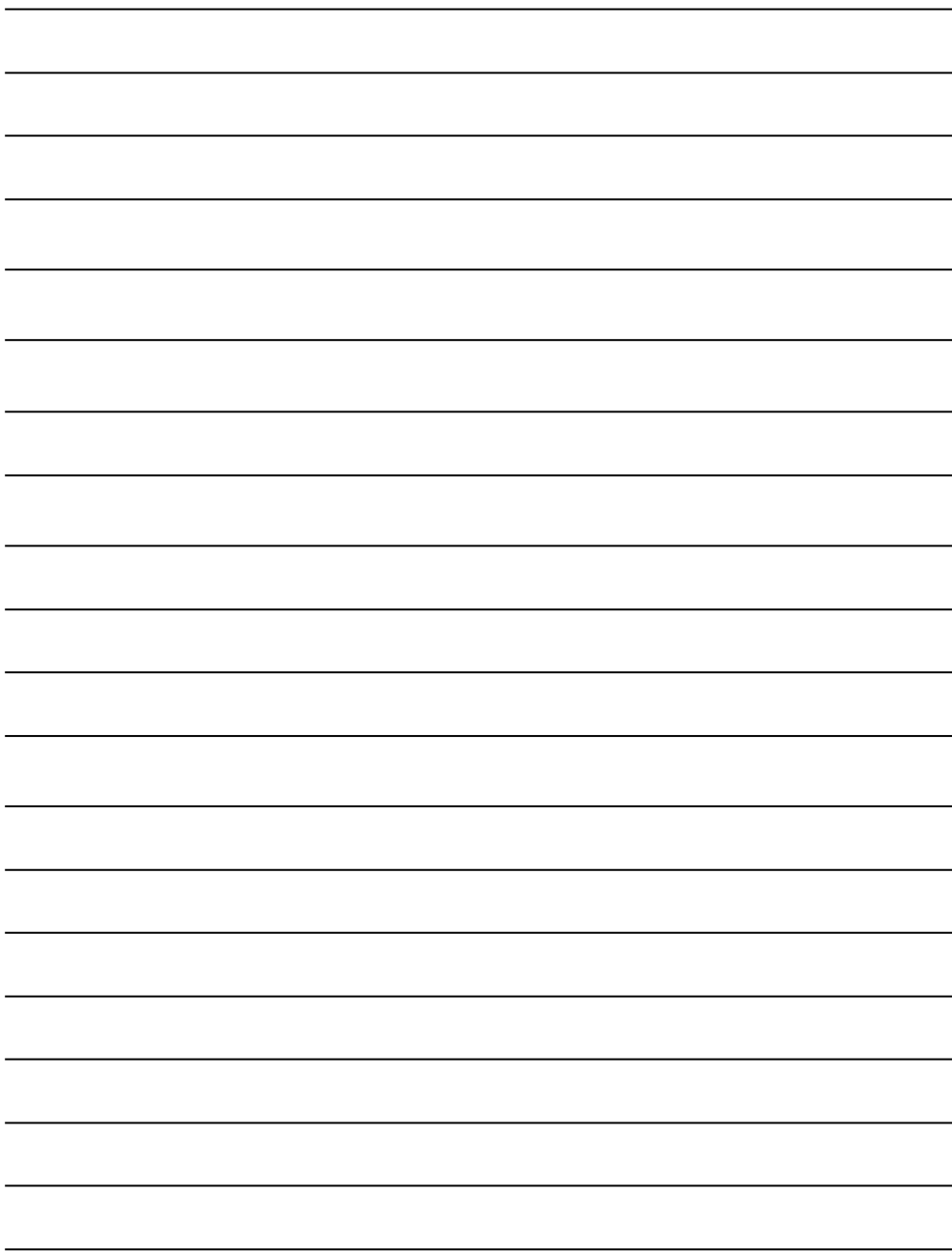
